## Concert of Prayers

Concert of Prayers is an uninterrupted series of spoken prayer, chants and music woven together to form an experience that parallels the experience of entering a temple. The 17th century poet Tukaram Maharaj wrote “There is so much sweetness in chanting. There is so much nectar in the name of God you won’t have to go to any holy place. As you repeat the name of God, your entire body becomes a holy place. Your mind itself becomes a holy place.” Concert of Prayers is an event devoted to the positive effect of prayer and beautiful music. In Concert of Prayers, there’s the beginning, the initial adjustment to the vibrations in the room, then a quieting of the body, heart and mind. Participants move into a deeper peaceful reflection, then to a completion, an ending, celebrating the blessings of life.

## Chanting Courses

Sanctorum combines classical music, chants, and improvisations with flute, cello, guitar, African drums, piano, and violin.
